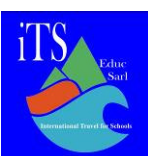




## Paris, FRANCE

<b>Day 1</b> <b>Wed.</b> <b>22/6</b>	Pickup from CDG Airport at 14.10 and meet with our staff. Overview of the programme for the week, transfer by private coach and check-in at our <i>Hotel Cheyenne in Disneyland Paris</i> . From there, we will go straight into the park to enjoy it at night, watching the fireworks after we had dinner at <i>King Ludwig's Castle Restaurant</i>
<b>Day 2</b> <b>Thursd.</b> <b>23/6</b>	After breakfast and check out, we will spend the whole day at <b>Disneyland Paris</b> , experiencing the famous rides and special attractions of the amusement park. <i>Space Mountain</i> is always a favourite and we recommend that you make use of the <i>Fast Pass</i> system to help avoid the queues for the popular rides. Lunch will be at your leisure inside the park. We will finally exit the park, get our luggage and have our private bus transfer into Paris for dinner at <i>Flam's Restaurant</i> and check-in at our <i>Holiday Inn Hotel</i>
<b>Day 3</b> <b>Frid.</b> <b>24/6</b>	After breakfast we will travel to the <b>Château de Versailles</b> , an amazing and historic castle close to the capital. This former royal palace is stunning and the gardens are equally magnificent. We will have lunch on the site and will then travel back to the centre of Paris in the afternoon. Once there we will visit of the <b>Musée du Louvre</b> ; all the favourites are here – the Mona Lisa and the great Masters. We recommend that you hire an audio guide in order that you choose which exhibits you want to learn about. Dinner at <i>Bistro Romain</i> and head back to our hotel
<b>Day 4</b> <b>Sat.</b> <b>25/6</b>	Our day will start with a visit of the <b>Musée d'Orsay</b> (famous for Impressionism Art) before we <b>walk through the Jardin des Tuileries up to Place de la Concorde</b> , reaching <b>La Madeleine</b> and <b>Place Vendôme</b> , famous for its jewellery stores. Then we will use the metro to reach the center of the French capital and admire <b>Notre-Dame Cathedral</b> . This wonderful Gothic masterpiece, famous after Victor Hugo's novel, is a highlight, even if Quasimodo doesn't appear. The Rose Window is magnificent. We will conclude our day with a walk through the Marais district, the Middle-Age part of Paris. Dinner nearby at French Brasserie <i>Chez Clément Bastille</i>
<b>Day 5</b> <b>Sund.</b> <b>26/6</b>	After breakfast we will reach the north of Paris and enter the <b>Science Museum</b> to visit the <i>Explora</i> Exhibition and enjoy a 3D movie there. After lunch on the site, we will take a <b>walk inside the Latin area</b> before we go and watch <i>Paris Story</i> , a 45-minute presentation on the history of the French capital. Then we will experience <b>Les Etoiles du Rex</b> , a travel to the heart of the biggest movie theatre in Europe and will finally go for <i>dinner in town</i> before we return to our hotel for a well-deserved night
<b>Day 6</b> <b>Mond.</b> <b>27/6</b>	After breakfast we will reach Paris' most famous attraction, the <b>Eiffel Tower</b> . We will climb to the top and will then have lunch at the cafeteria. The views are sensational. Afterwards, we will descend to street level and enjoy a <b>boat cruise</b> along the Seine River before we go to the famous <b>Champs-Élysées</b> . In the evening, we will have dinner at <i>Hippopotamus Restaurant</i> and at dusk we will ascend the <b>Arc de Triomphe</b> for one of the finest night views of Paris. We will then return to the hotel completely tired, but full of images proving that Paris truly is the 'City of Lights'
<b>Day 7</b> <b>Tuesd.</b> <b>28/6</b>	Check out of our hotel after breakfast. We will then spend the morning visiting the <b>Montmartre District</b> , taking the stairs up to the Basilique du Sacré-Coeur. After lunch at a typical old Parisian café on Place du Tertre, we will take time to shop for last minute souvenirs in this Bohemian area. Back to our hotel and transfer by private bus to the airport for your flight home

<b>SAFETY</b>	Safety is an absolute priority with ITS trips. Our experienced and trained staff are all First Aid qualified. Each staff member has a mobile telephone for emergencies and overall communication. SPOT satellite SOS/GPS messenger is used on all trips to support each group. France has an extensive health care system. A complete risk assessment is provided for each trip.
<b>HEALTH</b>	It is recommended that you consult with your GP for the most up to date advice. General rules of hygiene must be followed. It is recommended that all students are healthy before travelling and bring with them any medication required. A good level of physical fitness is required for all participants. <b>VISA</b>	Please contact your local consulate for VISA information and requirements.
<b>MONEY</b>	Euro is the accepted currency of France. We recommend you exchange money before your departure or at the airport upon arrival. We also recommend you use an international credit card to minimise the amount of cash carried. Children should not carry a large amount of cash in any case.
<b>TOUR STYLE</b>	ITS Staff accompanies the group during the entire duration, organising all the activities and visits. Food will be authentic local cuisine. Public transport will be used whenever possible to experience the real Paris. Lunches can be arranged and included at additional cost; however we have found that students prefer to choose their own food once a day and get better overall better value for money accordingly.
<b>EQUIPMENT</b>	Equipment required for organised activities will be provided in the cost.
<b>BRING</b>	Temperatures can fluctuate so warm, waterproof and comfortable clothing is recommended. Not bringing a camera will be regretted. Comfortable walking shoes, back pack, water bottle and a hat are essentials.
<b>EXTRAS</b>	Students are accommodated in twin / triple rooms and staff in twin rooms. There is a supplement per night for any adult single rooms (subject to availability). Additional staff are welcome at 80% of the student price per person.
<b>CONDITIONS</b>	The price per student is based on the above offer and subject to a minimum 20 paying students.
