MONEY	Euro is the accepted currency of France. We recommend you exchange money before your departure or at the
	airport upon arrival. We also recommend you use an international credit card to minimise the amount of cash
	carried. Children should not carry a large amount of cash in any case.
TOUR STYLE	ITS Staff accompanies the group during the entire duration, organising all the activities and visits. Food will be
